HANDBOOK

The following is an extract from the MINUTES of the inaugural Meeting of the new ASSOCIATION, which was referred to as THE BRADFORD & DISTRICT RABBITS GOLF ASSOCIATION dated 9th April 1948.

"Invitations to attend this Meeting had been sent out by a small Committee of the Bradford Moor Golf Club, and the response was very encouraging.

There was an attendance of 28 and eleven Clubs were represented as follows: -

South Bradford, Bradford Moor, Otley, Cleckheaton, West Bowling, Woodhall Hills, Queensbury, Thornton, East Bierley, West Bradford and Phoenix Park.

The Chair was taken by Sam Chippendale Esq. of Bradford Moor Golf Club and he extended a hearty welcome to all the visitors".

There followed a discussion:

"Mr Chippendale was asked whether the Association would have the support of the West Riding Rabbits Golf Association as it was felt that such support and approval would be necessary if both Associations were to prosper. The Chairman said that he had the goodwill of the West Riding Rabbits but assured those present that our Association would be a separate entity from that body and would only be affiliated to it.

Thereupon a proposal was made by the Cleckheaton Representative, and seconded by the South Bradford Representative that "The Bradford & District Rabbits Golf Association" be, and is hereby formed, and this was carried without opposition.

It was agreed by Members of the Association that an ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING of the Association would be held at a suitable venue on April 30th 1948."

THE BRADFORD & DISTRICT RABBITS GOLF ASSOCIATION

CONSTITUTION AND RULES

The name of the Association shall be "The Bradford & District Rabbits Golf Association", affiliated to the Yorkshire Rabbit Golf Association.

DEFINITION

A rabbit is a male member of a golf club affiliated to England Golf whose handicap index is 15.0 or over. For all Association competitions he must also be a playing member aged 18 or over.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Association shall be to:

- (a) Promote the game of golf.
- (b) Stimulate and encourage the interests of the higher handicap players by arrangement of Rabbit competitions within the specified area and within the framework of individual member clubs.
- (c) Work for the benefit of the Association and give the fullest support to the parent body, namely the Yorkshire Rabbit Golf Association.
- (d) Organise and conduct social events, including meetings to impart a better knowledge of the game of golf to all Rabbits.
- (e) Encourage and develop the formation of Rabbit sections in golf clubs within the specified area.

ASSOCIATION YEAR

The Association year shall commence on January 1st and terminate on December 31st. The financial year will end on October 31st.

AFFILIATION FEE

Each affiliated club shall pay an annual fee to be decided by the executive committee, which shall be paid by February 28th.

MEMBERSHIP

The Rabbit section of any club within the area may become a member of the Association by making a formal application in writing to the Honorary Secretary of the Association and subject to the approval of the executive committee.

MANAGEMENT

The Association shall be managed by a committee comprising of the following:

- a. A president who may hold office for a period not exceeding two years.
- b. A vice-president (who shall not be a member of the same club as the president).
- c. A junior vice-president (who shall not be a member of the same club as the president or vice-president) if the committee shall deem it necessary.
- d. A secretary and a treasurer.
- e. A League secretary.
- f. A Chippendale Trophy secretary.
- g. A maximum of ten other members of the executive committee to be elected at the Annual General Meeting.

Any member of a club Rabbit section may be eligible for election to the executive committee or to any position on the YRGA committee.

Any member of the executive committee losing his Rabbit or membership status during his term of office shall have the option of remaining on the executive committee.

All the officials enumerated in sub section (a) to (g) above shall retire at the Annual General Meeting but all shall be eligible for re-election, except for the president, who may, however, accept another office.

Any casual vacancy or vacancies in the committee may be filled by the committee upon the same terms as apply to other members of the executive. Retiring presidents shall be entitled to sit as ex-officio members of the committee for so long as they so desire.

QUORUM

The quorum of the executive committee meeting shall be six.

WINDING UP

If the affairs of the Association shall be wound up for any reason the assets remaining after the payment of all debts shall be divided equally between affiliated clubs.

VOTING POWERS

The affairs of the Association shall be managed by an executive committee consisting of the officers, past and life vice presidents and an elected committee of ten, elected annually at the Annual General Meeting, each having one vote. In the event of a tie, the chairman will have a second and casting vote.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

An Annual General Meeting, to which all affiliated clubs may send members shall be held in the month of January (or early February), to elect officers, receive the secretary's report together with the treasurer's accounts and to transact any other business of the Association. At least 28 days' notice of this meeting shall be given.

Any resolutions or recommendations from the affiliated clubs shall be in the hands of the secretary at least 14 days before the Annual General Meeting. Only two members per club shall vote on any resolution.

Amendments may be made at the AGM and in accordance with general practice be voted upon prior to the proposals. All amendments must be proposed and seconded before consideration of the original proposal.

The following are entitled to attend the meeting: officers, members of the executive committee, past presidents and life vice-presidents, members of affiliated club Rabbit sections.

All present will be entitled to speak on any matter under consideration but only two representatives of each affiliated club Rabbit section will be entitled to vote. Representatives must have the authority of their Rabbit section to vote. Members of the executive will not have the right to vote unless representing an affiliated club Rabbit section.

A quorum shall be representatives of eight affiliated club Rabbit sections.

EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING

The executive committee may call an extraordinary General Meeting of the Association should it consider this necessary to deal with a matter of urgent importance, or in the event that it receives a request to do so from not less than eight affiliated golf club Rabbit sections. It must give not less than 14 days' notice of such a meeting.

GENERAL

All Competitions shall normally be played from the yellow tees and according to the Rules of Golf as laid down by the Royal and Ancient Club of St. Andrews and the Local Rules of the club where the competition takes place.

Any dispute whatsoever shall be decided by the executive committee or its appointed officers and their decision shall be final.

RULES OF COMPETITION

Anyone who is a playing member of a BDRGA affiliated Club with a handicap index of 15.0 upwards can play in Association competitions. At least 3 qualifying cards (as defined by England Golf) shall have been submitted in the previous 12 months to the date of the competition. The maximum playing handicap for the Presidents Cup, 9 hole, 18 hole and Team Championships shall be 36. The League and Chippendale competitions are subject to different rules (see pages 9 & 10).

B.D.R.G.A. Committee 2026

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RULES APPLICABLE TO ALL COMPETITIONS

Male members of England Golf affiliated clubs aged 18 or over with a handicap index of 15.0 or over are eligible to play in Association competitions.

ANY PLAYER WHO PLAYS IN ANY OF THE BDRGA COMPETITIONS AND LEAGUE MATCHES MUST PRESENT ON THE DAY A HANDICAP INDEX CERTIFICATE OR ELECTRONIC DISPLAY DATED NO EARLIER THAN 28 DAYS PRIOR TO THE COMPETITION DATE.

FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION

The Executive Committee shall be responsible for organising any competition and drawing up and amending (as appropriate) competition rules. Its decision shall be final.

All players must present on the day proof of handicap e.g. certificate

LEAGUE RULES

1. A league team consists of 3 players: one in each handicap index range 15.0-17.4, 17.5-20.4 and 20.5 and upwards. Should a player's handicap fall below the lower limit within the previous 7 days they may still play in the same section - the "7 day rule" applies. If this does happen evidence must be provided to the opposing team captain and forwarded to the league secretary.
2. Matches are played between members of the same handicap range and no shots are given in any section. Should a team not be able to provide a player in any of the two lower Handicap ranges, then that team can play a substitute player from a higher handicap range. The substitute player must play off the lower handicap and no shots are given or received.
3. The play is match play over 18 holes and to decide the outcome the result of each section counts.
4. Points are awarded as follows: win - 2 points, draw - 1 point, lose - 0 points. Example: - Home Team A v Visitors Team B. Team A: 15.0-17.4 wins 2 and 1, Team A: 17.5-20.4 halves, Team A: 20.5 and upwards loses 2 and 1. Match Result: -Team A, 3 points, Team B, 3 points.
5. All league matches shall be started between 5.00pm and 6.00pm on Thursday evenings or at a time mutually agreed by the captains involved. If both clubs agree, it is permissible to switch home and away fixtures, but they must advise the League Secretary beforehand. It is the responsibility of the League home club correspondent to report the result of the match to the League Secretary. This should include home and away players' full names and be submitted no later than 12.00 (midday) the Friday immediately following the match, but preferably before 22.30 on the day of the match. Failure to do so will result in the reduction of three points from the home team involved. The away team will score whatever points they actually won. In all cases the decision of the League Secretary will be final.
6. If, for any valid reason, play is unable to start, or has to be discontinued, then the match will have to be completed within thirteen days of the due date, or the end of the season, **whichever comes sooner**, by mutual agreement between the two teams. In the case of a discontinued match, play will re-start at the tee of the hole where play was abandoned. In a replayed match, if any of the original players are not available, substitution is permitted.
7. If a club is unable to muster a full team or any players at all the result will be recorded as 1 UP to the other team. In the event of a tie for the league match play champion or to decide league winners, or promotion or relegation this result may be disregarded at the discretion of the League Secretary.
8. In the event of a tie to decide promotion or relegation the deciding factor shall be the number of matches won. If still level the decision will be based on individual results. **Holes won and lost.**
9. Promotion or relegation will be on a basis of two up and two down. At various times this may change (e.g. the 2021 season) or if the divisions need to be re-balanced, in the event of withdrawal or addition of clubs.
10. In the event of a dispute, the circumstances must be reported to the League Secretary within 7 days of the match in question having been played, and his decision will be final.

THE DAVID OAKES TROPHY: CHAMPION LEAGUE RABBIT

The first ten matches that an individual plays during the season count towards the final points total. Points are awarded on this basis: a win will count as two points, a draw as one point and a loss as no points. The player who scores the most points in the fewest games will be awarded the prize.

In the event of a tie, the winner be determined by the number of holes won less the number of holes lost over the ten-match qualifying period. In the event of an opposing player not turning up, that game will not count.

CHIPPENDALE TROPHY

A team shall consist of two Players, aged 18 or over with fully-developed Handicap Indexes, one 15.0 – 20.4 and one 20.5 and upwards. Proof of HI is to be exchanged before the start of each match.

All member clubs may enter 2 teams. The format of the competition shall be a foursome played over 18 holes from scratch as match play on a knock out basis, played to a sudden death, if necessary, extra holes being from the 1st, and so on until there is a winner. The onus is upon each team to contact the other as soon as possible. The home club should offer the away club three possible dates on which to play. Any disputes will be arbitrated by the Competition Secretary. The penalty for breaking this Rule is disqualification of BOTH Teams.

The winners of the A and B sections shall play off on the same basis over 18 holes.

Both the semi-finals and the final shall be on neutral courses to be arranged by the Chippendale Secretary. A player who plays in the A team shall NOT be eligible to play in the B Team and vice-versa. Penalty for such infringement shall be the disqualification of the team. Failure to notify the Competition Secretary of the result by the winning team by the final date of each round shall result in disqualification. If playing a match on the final day, please notify the Chippendale Secretary beforehand, in case the result cannot be got to him on time.
